



Directions: BuitenZorg, 42 Pagasvlei Road, Constantia 7806

- BuitenZorg is only a short driving distance from Cape Town International Airport, no more than a thirty-minute journey
- Drive on the N2 in the direction of Cape Town
- Take exit 6 for M3/Rhodes Drive
- Merge onto M3 - take exit 15 for M38/Kendal Road toward Meadowridge
- Turn right onto Kendal Road/M38 - Turn left onto Spaanschemat River Rd/M42 (Constantia Emporium shopping mall is ahead)
- At the roundabout take the 3rd exit & stay on Spaanschemat River Rd/M42
- Slight right at the top of the hill onto Klein Constantia Road
- Turn right onto Pagasvlei Road (Huis-In-Bos is on the corner)
- Drive straight on and about 100 metres down the road you will come to a small roundabout
- Take the first left on the small roundabout taking the lane (with a red brick island in the centre) towards Mount Prospect Retirement Estate
- BuitenZorg is at the end of the private lane on the left (opposite the white gate entrance to Mount Prospect)
- Push the buzzer for the Manor House and we will open the gates for you.

**Coach House**

Drive straight up the wooden gates and immediately to the right is a driveway to the Coach House. There is enough space for several vehicles here.

Pool Villa

The villa is a little further up on the right as you drive up the driveway through the wooden gates. Once you have unloaded your bags, please always park your vehicle directly outside the gym (the front door is adjacent), there is enough space for two vehicles.

Vineyard Cottage

Drive straight up to almost the very top of the driveway and you'll see a small space to park to your left (next to a lovely Lilac tree). The path to the cottage leads from here. There is enough space for two vehicles here.

Your hosts John/Sharon will welcome you, and once you have unpacked, we will store your empty luggage away for you if you'd prefer.

Please may we kindly ask that you avoid parking on the main gravel driveway where the small round fountain is (simply because our teenagers are learning to drive!). However, if you have guests visiting you at any time, they are of course very welcome to park there.
